



STEVE AND JULIE NOVAK ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

The Steve and Julie Novak Endowed Scholarship in Public Administration is awarded annually to a student in either the Master of Arts or Doctorate in Public Administration degree program.

Steve Novak, a Hamline University College of Liberal Arts graduate, has had a long and distinguished career in both the Minnesota House of Representatives and the Senate and is well known for his commitment to public service. The Novaks wish to encourage and support others who share a dedication to public service through this endowed scholarship of \$1200.00.

Both domestic and international students may apply by submitting a personal purpose statement along with a cover letter in which the applicant's name, address, phone and fax numbers, e-mail address, and cumulative grade point average are listed.

The personal purpose statement should address the following criteria for the award:

1. Course work or professional or volunteer experience demonstrating a commitment not only to public service but also to service to the larger community.
2. Academic achievement
Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.5 for a student who has completed at least 2 semesters of either the masters or doctorate program or a 3.0 cumulative grade point or its equivalent in undergraduate/graduate school for a student who is entering the first year of either program.
3. Financial need
Although a factor to be considered in awarding the scholarship, financial need is not a prerequisite for application or award.
